What is HEALTHY? Find Out! ?	HEALTHY? Find Out! collects the latest information on health topics into one easy-to-use tool called a kiosk.
What is a kiosk?	A kiosk is a computer with special information to be used by the public.
How does it work?	Touch the kiosk screen to begin. A “menu” will appear with a list of health topics you can choose from. Touch a health topic to start your session. Your session will take about 2-3 minutes. The kiosk will ask you several questions about your diet and life style. Touch the screen to answer these questions. Use keyboard to enter weight and age. <i>Your answers are not stored in this kiosk.</i>
What does it do?	You can use this tool to find out if you are at risk for conditions such as cancer, diabetes, heart disease, osteoporosis and stroke.
What is a risk factor?	A risk factor is anything that increases your chances of getting a disease. <i>Increased risk does not mean you will get the disease, but knowing your risk will help you understand what to discuss with your physician.</i>
How can the kiosk help me?	At end of your session, the kiosk will display a graph of your risk profile with tips for prevention. Touch “Print” button to get copy of your risk profile. Touch a “phone number” on Healthcare Provider page for help with scheduling an appointment.
